**U.S. REP. DAVIS TO SPEAK ON ELECTION SEASON
AT MEDIA OF BIRMINGHAM EVENT**

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — U.S. Rep. Artur Davis will talk about the local and national elections at the October meeting of Media of Birmingham. Davis is the first keynote speaker in the MOB's new series of networking and training opportunities for media professionals.
